RE: REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATION - 4TH MAINLAND BRIDGE (4MB) PROJECT

We refer to the Request for Qualification (RfQ) issued on 10th February, 2020 in respect of the proposed design, development, construction, procurement, financing, commissioning, operation and maintenance of the Lagos State Fourth Mainland Bridge (the Project); and our announcement dated 25th April, 2020, detailing the ten (10) responses received by the Lagos State Government (LASG) in response to the RfQ (the Applications).

Following the receipt by LASG of the Applications, the Project Evaluation Committee, comprising the financial, technical and legal advisers to LASG (the Evaluation Committee) as well as representatives of the LASG, commenced its evaluation of the ten (10) Applicants' technical and financial capacity; in accordance with the terms of the RfQ (the Evaluation).

Further to:

- the withdrawal by China Harbour Engineering Co. Ltd. (Nigeria) of its Application; and
- the submission by Mutual Commitment Company Limited of its Application after the stipulated time on the date of the Application Deadline;

The foregoing two (2) Applications were discountenanced and disqualified respectively by the Evaluation Committee.

As such, the Evaluation Committee is now carrying out the Evaluation on the following eight (8) Applicants, who have been listed in no particular order or ranking:

- CCECC Nigeria Limited;
- CGGC-CGC Joint Venture;

- China State Construction Engineering Corporation Nigeria Limited;
- IC İÇTAŞ İnşaat San ve Tic. A.Ş I Conds. INds. And Trade Corp;
- IV Ingenieros Consultores, S.A, SA through Makais Energy International
- Julius Berger Nigeria Plc;
- Mota-Engil &CCCC Consortium; and
- Power Construction Corporation of China (referred to as Power China Int'l)

For the avoidance of doubt, this announcement is not an indication that the above-listed Applicants have been shortlisted as Pre-Qualified Bidders for the next stage of the Selection/Bidding Process, being the Request for Proposal (RfP) stage.

As such, LASG will in due course announce which of the aforementioned Applicants have emerged as successful Pre-Qualified Bidders, who shall be eligible for participation in the RfP stage of the Selection/Bidding Process.

Kindly recall that LASG is not responsible for any costs or expenses that any Applicant may incur, or may have incurred, in the course of, in connection with or in relation to the Selection/Bidding Process.
